Deciduous Trees, Shade & Ornamental



Alder, Prairie Horizon Manchurian
Alnus hirsuta 'Harbin', Zone 2-8, 35' H x 20' W, a fast growing, cold hardy tree for difficult, dry locations. Dark green foliage, purple catkins followed by brown strobiles in fall. NDSU intro



Birch, Parkland Pillar

Betula platyphylla 'Jefpark', Zone 3-7, 40 H x 7 W, fast growing selection with an extremely narrow, dense form. White bark and lustrous green foliage that turns golden yellow in the fall



Aspen, Guardian Columnar

Populus tremuloides 'Guardian', Zone 2 -6, 40 H x 10 W, fast-growing with an upright, columnar form. Resistant to common diseases and pests. Leaves turn vibrant yellow in fall. Ideal for privacy screens or windbreaks



Birch, River

Betula Nigra, Zone 3-9, 35-50 H x 25-40 W, upright rounded habit, white bark exfoliating to copper-bronze, green foliage, yellow fall color.



Aspen, Quaking

Populus Tremuloides, Zone 2-7, 35-55 H x 20-30 W, leaves tremble in light breeze, yellow fall color, smooth light bark w/ dark knots and horizontal scars



Birch, Royal Frost

Betula Populofia 'x B. Hybrid. Crimson Frost 'Royal Frost', Zone 3-6, 30-40 H x 15-20 W, Stunning deep red-purple leaves and white bark. Bright fall colors.



Aspen, Swedish Columnar

Populus Tremula 'Erecta', Zone 2-5, 40 H x 10 W, very narrow form great for small spaces, flat, rounded leaves give visual appeal and soothing sound.



Birch, Whitespire

Betula Populifolia 'Whitespire', Zone 3-7, 20-40 H x 15-20 W, upright habit, non-exfoliating bark, green foliage, yellow fall color.



Birch, Dakota Pinnacle

Betula Platyphylla 'Fargo', Zone 3-7, 40 H x 15 W, narrow columnar to pyramidal habit, slightly exfoliated bark, green foliage, golden yellow fall color.



Birch, Young's Weeping

Betula Pendula 'Youngii', Zone 2-7, 8-10 H x 15 W, unusual small tree with very pendulous branches, mounding form, strong trunk with age.



Deciduous Trees, Shade & Ornamental, cont.

Buckeye, Ohio

Aesculus glabra, Zone 3-7, 25-40' H x 25-40' W, rounded habit & dense canopy, yellow flowers attract pollinators, capsules contain shiny, rich brown seeds "buckeyes". beautiful landscape, boulevard or shade tree



Crabapple, Prairifire

Malus x 'Prairifire', Zone 4-8, 15-20 H x 15-20 W, upright form, reddish new foliage turns dark green, deep pink spring flowers, persistent red-purple fruit



Cherry, Klondike Amur

Prunus maackii 'Jefdike', Zone 2-8, flowering, dainty racemes of fragrant white flowers, stunning exfoliating bark, low maintenance, immune to black knot



Crabapple, Purple Spire

Malus 'Jefspire', Zone 4-7, 20 H x 6 W, columnar form. Features purple foliage, pink flowers in spring, and small dark red fruit. Disease-resistant, perfect for narrow spaces or vertical accents



Crabapple, Coralburst

Malus 'Coralcole', Zone 3-7, 8-12 H x 10-15 W, Compact, very dense, Symmetrical rounded head, pink blossoms and bronze fruit, lush green leaves.



Crabapple, Showtime

Malus x 'Shotizam', Zone 4-8, 15-22 H x 12-20 W, heavy blooming showy pink flowers, dark green foliage with reddish tone, bright red persistent fruit



Crabapple, Emerald Spire Rosybloom

Malus x adstringens 'Jefgreen', Zone 4-7, 20 H x 6 W, narrow, columnar form, pink buds open to white flowers in spring, followed by small red fruit. Disease-resistant and ideal for small spaces or as a vertical accent



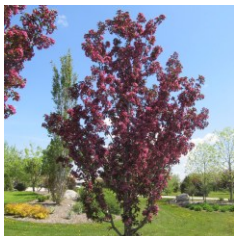
Crabapple, Snowdrift

Malus 'Snowdrift', Zone 4-8, 15-20 H x 15-20 W, red buds open to fragrant white flowers, glossy green foliage, orange red fruit persists into winter, good disease resistance



Crabapple, Gladiator Rosybloom

Malus x adstringens 'Durleo', Zone 2-8, 20' H x 13' W, profusion of bright pink flowers, small reddish-purple fruit. Dark and glossy bronze-purple leaves remain lush all season, highly disease



Crabapple, Spring Snow

Malus 'Spring Snow', Zone 4-7, 15-25 H x 15-20 W, brilliant white flowers, bright green foliage turns golden yellow in fall, fruitless.

Crabapple, Starlite

Malus x 'Jeflita', Zone 4-7, 20-25 H x 15-20 W, glossy dark green foliage, showy, snow white flowers, small but vibrant candy apple red persistent fruit.



Hawthorn, Snowbird

Crataegus x mordenensis 'Snowbird', Zone 3, 15-20 H x 12-20 W, small round tree, double white spring flowers, glossy green foliage turns yellow in fall, sparse red fruit, good urban tolerance, can be susceptible to fireblight



Elm, Accolade

Ulmus x 'Morton', Zone 4-9, 50-60 H x 25-40 W, Vase shaped, vigorous growth, dark green foliage, yellow fall color, winged seeds, excellent DED resistance



Honeylocust, Northern Acclaim

Gleditsia triacanthos var. inermis 'Harve', Zone 3-6, 40-50 H x 30-35 W, thornless, seedless, great winter hardiness, golden yellow fall color, drought and pH tolerant



Elm, Prairie Expedition

Ulmus Americana 'Lewis & Clark', Zone 3-9, 60' H x 40' W, NDSU intro, cold hardy, DED resistant, medium to fast growing, umbrella like form typifies American Elm



Honeylocust, Skyline

Gleditsia triacanthos var. inermis 'Skycole', Zone 3-8, 35-45 H x 25-35 W, thornless, nearly seedless, tolerant of adverse conditions, sun spotted shade



Elm, Princeton

Ulmus Americana 'Princeton', Zone 3-9, 50-70 H x 30-50 W, Broad rounded crown, dark green foliage turns yellow,



Hydrangea, Tree, Quick Fire

Hydrangea paniculata 'Quick Fire' (Tree Form), Zone 4-8, 8 H x 6 W, cone shaped white blooms turn pink red, blooms early on new wood, cold hardy and heat tolerant



Hackberry, Common

Celtis occidentalis, Zone 2-9, 40-60 H x 25-45 W, Native to ND, stucco-like bark, very adaptable, drought tolerant, narrow young, broad arching with age



Lilac, Tree, Dwarf Korean

Syringa meyeri 'Palibin', Zone 4-8, 5-7 H x 5-7 W, tolerates drought, heat, alkaline and salt, fragrant early spring blooms, can be trimmed back to bloom again



Deciduous Trees, Shade & Ornamental, cont.



Lilac, Tree, Ivory Silk Japanese
Syringa reticulata 'Ivory Silk', Zone 4-8, 20 H x 15 W, white flower plumes bloom in late spring, hardy and adaptable, dark green leaves turn rich golden-bronze in fall, shiny brown bark



Linden, Redmond
Tilia americana 'Redmond', Zone 2-8, 50-70 H x 30-45 W, ND Native, large oval-rounded crown, tolerates drought and clay, showy fragrant flower



Lilac, Tree, Summer Charm
Syringa pekinensis 'Summer Charm', Zone 3-8, 20 H x 15 W, upright oval habit, dark green foliage, creamy white fragrant flowers, amber exfoliating bark



Linden, True North
Tilia americana 'Duro', Zone 3-7, 40-50 H x 13-20 W, Narrow pyramidal linden for boulevards and tight spaces, hardy with strong central leader, fragrant yellow flowers, performs best with consistent moisture, avoid severe drought



Linden, Greenspire
Tilia cordata 'Greenspire', Zone 4-7, 40-50 H x 30-35 W, Little leaf Linden with strong leader, dark green foliage, yellow in fall, excellent for urban boulevards



Maple, Autumn Blaze
Acer x freemanii 'Jeffersred', Zone 3-8, 40-55 H x 30-40 W, adaptable maple, showy red fall colors, tolerates wet soil



Linden, Harvest Gold
Tilia x 'Harvest Gold', Zone 2-8, 25-45 H x 25-30 W, exfoliating bark with age, golden buds, golden fall color, Fragrant flowers, excellent medium boulevard tree



Maple, Columnar Norway
Acer platanoids 'Columnare', Zone 4-7, 20-35 H x 15 W, rigidly columnar, coarse texture, early yellow flowers, urban tolerant, require moist soil



Linden, Lighthouse
Tilia x Flavescens 'Jefhouse', Zone 3, 40 H x 30 W, narrow pyramidal shade tree, dark green foliage turns golden in fall, fragrant yellow flowers, urban tolerant



Maple, Crimson Sentry
Acer platanoids 'Crimson Sentry', Zone 4-9, 25 H x 15 W, foliage emerges bright crimson, deep maroon in summer, bronzes in fall, urban tolerant



Deciduous Trees, Shade & Ornamental, cont.



Maple, Flame Amur

Acer ginnala 'Flame', Zone 3-8, 20 H x 20 W, red seeds contrast green foliage, flame fall colors, drought tolerant



Maple, Silver Queen

Acer saccharinum 'Silver Queen', Zone 3-9, 40-50 H x 40-50 W, Fast growing ND native maple, surprising tolerance for poor dry soils, yellow fall color



Maple, Hot Wings Tatarian

Acer tataricum ginnala 'Hot Wings', Zone 4-10, 18 H x 18 W, Bright red summer seeds contrast green foliage, tolerate dry, clay, alkaline challenging soils



Maple, Fall Fiesta Sugar

Acer saccharum 'Fall Fiesta', Zone 4-8, 50-70 H x 40-50 W, symmetrical shade tree, thick glossy green foliage turns orange red yellow in fall, prefers moist well drained soils, intolerant of salt and compaction



Maple, Regal Celebration

Acer x freemanii 'Regal Celebration', Zone 3, 45 H x 30 W, fast growing shade tree, glossy green foliage turns bright red in fall, broadly oval form, urban tolerant



Mountain Ash, Russian European

Sorbus aucuparia 'Rossica', Zone 3, 25-40 H x 15-25 W, hardy mountain ash with white spring flowers and orange red berries, upright oval form, cold tolerant, prone to fireblight and leaf spot in humid sites



Maple, Ruby Slippers Amur

Acer ginnala 'Ruby Slippers', Zone 3-8, 15-20 H x 15-20 W, compact small maple, bright red samaras in summer, foliage turns red orange in fall, drought tolerant once established



Ninebark, Summer Wine, Tree

Physocarpus opulifolius 'Summer Wine' (Tree Form), Zone 3-7, 6-8 H x 4-6 W, deep wine foliage and pink white spring flowers, compact canopy, exfoliating bark adds winter interest, good mildew resistance



Maple, Sienna Glenn

Acer x freemanii 'Sienna', Zone 3-8, 40-50 H x 35-40 W, Stronger wood, better drought, salt & alkaline tolerance than Autumn Blaze, similar colors



Oak, Admiration Hybrid

Quercus x jackiana 'Jefmir', Zone 2-8, 40 H x 30 W, very hardy hybrid oak, glossy dark green foliage turns golden in fall and holds into winter, shaggy bark, drought tolerant once established



Deciduous Trees, Shade & Ornamental, cont.



Oak, Bur

Quercus macrocarpa, Zone 3-8, 70-90 H x 60-90W, ND Native, furrowed bark, dark green foliage turns yellow in fall



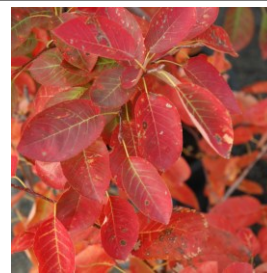
Rose, Knock Out, Patio Tree

Rosa 'Knock Out' (Tree Form), Zone 4-9, 4-7 H x 3-4 W, nonstop cherry red blooms from spring to frost, glossy green foliage, great patio accent, excellent disease resistance



Oak, Kindred Spirit

Quercus robur x bicolor 'Nadler', Zone 4-8, 30 H x 6 W, Tight Columnar habit, mildew, drought and urban tolerant



Serviceberry, Autumn Brilliance

Amelanchier x grandiflora 'Autumn Brilliance', Zone 3-9, 20 H x 20 W, early spring flowers yield to small edible fruits in summer, fruits persist into winter, radiant orange-red fall color



Poplar, Prairie Sky

Populus x canadensis 'Prairie Sky', Zone 2-8, 60 H x 12-16 W, Seedless, upright form, very fast growing, and long lived, resistant to stem canker and leaf rust.



Walnut, Black

Juglans nigra, Zone 4-9, 50-75 H x 30-50 W, large native nut tree with bold foliage and edible walnuts, tough and drought tolerant, produces juglone that can inhibit nearby plants



Poplar, Siouxland Cottonless

Populus deltoides 'Siouxland', Zone 3-9, 80 H x 40 W, Fast growing, cottonless, tolerant of many difficult ND sites



Willow, Laurel

Salix pentandra, Zone 3, 25-45 H x 20-35 W, fast growing willow with glossy dark green leaves, good for moist sites and windbreaks, tolerates wet soils, can yellow in alkaline soils



Poplar, Sundancer

Populus x 'ACWS151', Zone 2-8, 40 H x 10 W, Narrow, upright form, outstanding growth rate, excellent shelter tree, resistant to bronze leaf disease



Willow, Prairie Cascade

Salix 'Prairie Cascade', Zone 3-10, 30 H x 40 W, golden arching branches & furrowed bark add winter interest, prefers wet soil, but tolerates much



Evergreens & Conifers



Arborvitae, North Pole

Thuja occidentalis 'Art Boe', Zone 3-8, 10-15 H x 3-5 W, Narrow Columnar habit, resists winter burn, yellow green young trees turn dark green with age



Juniper, Skyrocket

Juniperus scopulorum 'Skyrocket', Zone 4-9, 15-20 H x 2-3 W, Stately columnar form, bluish green foliage, requires little care, deer/rabbit resistant, urban/dry tolerant



Arborvitae, Skybound

Thuja occidentalis 'Skybound', Zone 3-7, 15-18 H x 3-5 W, Stately columnar habit, dark green foliage, avoid windy/exposed/dry sites



Juniper, Taylor

Juniperus virginiana 'Taylor', Zone 3-9, 20-30 H x 3 W, softer green foliage with tones of blue, very narrow columnar form, very dense, great for a screen or a regal entryway accent



Juniper, Medora

Juniperus scopulorum 'Medora', Zone 3-7, 10-15 H x 4-5 W, from the badlands of North Dakota, narrow, columnar pyramid with blue-green foliage holds form with little or no pruning



Juniper, Wichita Blue

Juniperus scopulorum 'Wichita Blue', Zone 3-7, 10-15 H x 4-6 W, Silvery-blue foliage, dense, pyramidal shape, drought-tolerant, low maintenance, ideal for hedges, screens, and specimen planting, deer-resistant



Juniper, Moonglow

Juniperus Scopulorum 'Moonglow', Zone 3-7, 8' W x 20' H, showy, silvery blue foliage on a broad pyramidal form, tough plant has a dense, compact-branching habit that resists grazing by deer



Pine, Tannenbaum Mugo

Pinus mugo 'Tannenbaum', Zone 3-7, 12-15 H x 5-8 W, perfect Christmas-tree shape, rich green with a hint of gray/blue, even during winter, adaptable to a wide range of environmental and climatic conditions and very hardy.



Juniper, Rocky Mountain

Juniperus scopulorum, Zone 3-9, 25-45 H x 15 W, ND Native, dense pyramidal growth, very drought & pH tolerant



Pine, White Columnar

Pinus strobus 'Fastigiata', Zone 3-8, 30-40 H x 7-10 W, Columnar ascending branches, requires moist acidic soil, intolerant of compacted, clay, alkaline soils or pollution



Evergreens & Conifers, cont.



Pine, Ponderosa

Pinus ponderosa, Zone 3-7, 55-90 H x 25-30 W, ND Native, pyramidal when young, becoming open-crowned with age, prefers moist, well drained acidic soils, but tolerates drought, slightly alkaline and saline soils, fast growing conifer for ND



Pine, Swiss Stone, Prairie Statesman

Pinus cembra 'Herman', Zone 3-8, 12-15 H x 6-8 W, Narrowly Columnar, Elegant soft needles, drought tolerant and cold hardy, NDSU Introduction



Pine, Swiss Stone, Chalet

Pinus cembra 'Chalet' Zone 3-8 10-15 H x 3-5 W, narrowly conical form, *Pinus cembra* 'Chalet' grows slowly into a dense, compact tree that is perfect for today's smaller landscapes. Clusters of soft-to-the-touch, blue-green needles with white undersides add a fluffy elegance to this extremely hardy choice.



Pine, Scotch

Pinus sylvestris, Zone 2-9, 35-60 H x 25-35 W, Scaly flaking rusty colored bark, shorter needles and more dense than Ponderosa Pine, Pyramidal when young, becoming open and irregular with age, very cold hardy and adaptable to many sites, fastest growing conifer for ND



Spruce, Colorado

Picea pungens, Zone 2-7, 50-80 H x 15-25 W, Choice specimen tree, native to inter-mountain states of west, tall & broad dense pyramidal growth, scaly or flaky bark, blue to green needles with sharp points, deer/rabbit resistant, most drought tolerant of spruce, prefers well-drained moist acidic soils



Pine, Scotch, Columnar

Pinus Sylvestris 'Fastigiata', Zone 2-8, 15-20 H x 3-5 W, Columnar ascending branches, very cold hardy and adaptable, scaly flaky rust colored bark, moderately fast growing

Spruce, Black Hills

Picea glauca 'Densata', Zone 2-8, 35-50 H x 15-25 W, ND Native, symmetrical cone shape, denser than species, less prone to snow load damage, bright green new foliage turns blue-green, softer needles than Colorado spruce, deer/rabbit resistant, drought tolerant, prefers well-drained moist acidic soils



Spruce, Sester Dwarf

Picea Pungens 'Sester Dwarf', Zone 2-7, 10 H x 6 W, Classic blue needles and conical form in a compact form, growing only a few inches each year



Spruce, Fat Albert

Picea pungens 'Fat Albert', Zone 2-7, 40 H x 20 W, establishes the iconic broad pyramidal form and silvery blue needles of the Colorado spruce quickly, 10-15 HxW in 10 years



Spruce, Colorado Fastigiata

Picea pungens 'Fastigiata', Zone 2-7, 12-18 H x 4-6' W, narrow pyramidal columnar growth, silvery-blue needles, drought tolerant once established



Spruce, The Blues Weeping

Picea pungens 'The Blues', Zone 2-8, size varies with structure, may be trained to grow along fences, walls, railings and other structure, growing 5-10" per year

Juniper, Old Gold Pom Pom

Juniperus chinensis 'Old Gold', Zone 2-7, 2-3 H x 3-4 W, gold-yellow new growth with green foliage, heavily pruned to create/maintain Pom Pom shape, may have slight bronzing in winter



Spruce, Dwarf Alberta, Spiral

Picea glauca 'Conica (spiral)' Zone 2-8, 8 H x 5 W, cone shaped spruce trimmed into spiral form, moderate growing, trim annually to maintain form, superb formal statement, protect in winter to prevent burn



Pine, Scotch Sculpture

Pinus sylvestris, Zone 2-9, Select specimens chosen for their dense growth are heavily pruned to create tufts of dense new growth and needles, prune to maintain this habit



Spruce, Dwarf Blue Globe

Picea pungens f. *glauca* 'Globosa', Zone 3-7, 3-4 H x 3-4 W, Compact, very dense, Symmetrical rounded head, grafted to a bare trunk, the head continues to expand, but the trunk will not elongate



Evergreen Shrubs



Boxwood, Green Gem

Buxus x 'Green Gem', Zone 4-9, 2-3 H x 3-4 W, small, lush mound of emerald green foliage, some winter bronzing, protect from dry winter winds



Juniper, Blue Rug

Juniperus horizontalis 'Wiltonii', Zone 3-9, 3-6" H x 6-8' W, fine trailing juniper with uniform, full centered growth, silver-blue foliage covers ground quickly



Yew, Densi

Taxus x media 'Densiflora', Zone 4-7, 3-4 H x 4-6 W, light green new growth on dark green foliage with scarlet red cones which resemble berries



Pine, Slowmound Mugo

Pinus mugo 'Slowmound', Zone 2-8, 1-2 H x 2-3 W, rugged cold hardy evergreen with fine textured foliage, slow growing mound shape



Yew, Hicks

Taxus x media 'Hicksii', Zone 4-7, 10-12 H x 3-4 W, long, upright branches and dense glossy green foliage make it perfect for a foundation, takes well to trimming and shaping



Yew, Dark Green Spreader

Taxus x media 'Dark Green', Zone 4-7, 4-5 H x 6-7 W, dark green color all year, prefers some shade and wind protection



Yew, Taunton

Taxus x media 'Tauntonii', Zone 4-7, 3-4 H x 4-6 W, dwarf spreading, yellow new growth turns dark green, slightly more wind resistant than other varieties



Fruit Trees, Edibles



Apple, Frostbite

Malus "MN447", Zone 3b, ripe: early to mid-Oct, extremely cold hardy, ultra sweet, good for cider, fresh, or dried chips, pair with Haralred, Honeycrisp or Norland



Cherry, Evans Bali

Prunus cerasus 'Evens Bali', Zone 3-9, 15-20 H x 10-15 W, showy white flowers come before leaves, bright red fruit in summer, jams, jellies, pies and wines, self-fertile, urban tolerant



Apple, Haralred

Malus 'Haralred', Zone 3, ripe: late-Sep early-Oct, redder and earlier than Haralson, easy to grow, eat fresh or bake, stores well, pair with Honeycrisp, Norland or Frostbite



Cherry, North Star

Prunus 'North Star', Zone 4-8, 8-10 H x 8-10 W, dwarf tree with high production for small spaces, spring flowers, textured bark for winter interest, eat fresh, jams, desserts and wines, self-fertile, urban tolerant



Apple, Honeycrisp

Malus 'MN1711', Zone 3, ripe: late-Sep, most popular apple in Midwest, sweet & balanced taste, crisp texture, great off the tree & store very well, pair with Haralred, Norland or Frostbite



Chokecherry, Canada Red Select

Prunus virginiana 'Schubert', Zone 2-7, 20-30 H x 15-20 W, white flowers, dark purple leaves, red fruit ripens to dark purple in fall, jams and wine, wildlife, self-fertile, tent caterpillars can be problem



Apple, Norland

Malus 'Norland', Zone 2, ripe: Sep, very cold hardy, natural semi-dwarf, pick before ripe to store, pair with Haralred, Honeycrisp or Frostbite

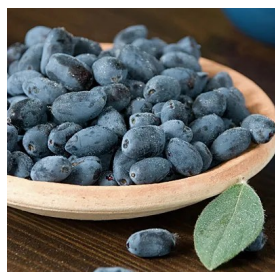

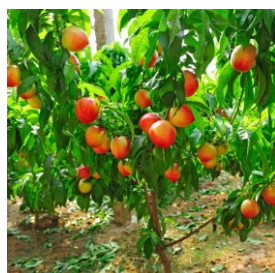

Pyrus communis 'Kieffer', Zone 4-8, Ripe: late-Sep, pick when firm, ripen off tree, self-fertile, but will pollinate others and produce more when paired with others, Euro-Asian Hybrid works with Bosc, Flemish, Parker, Luscious,



Plum, Toka
Prunus 'Toka', Zone 3, ripe: Aug, great pollinator, sweet spicy flavor, heavy producer, pair with Superior



Pear, Luscious
Pyrus 'Luscious', Zone 4-7, Ripe: late-Sep, flavor similar to Bartlett, firm but melting texture, Triploid variety **REQUIRES 2 other varieties to pollinate**, Parker, Kieffer, and/or Summer Crisp work

Amelanchier alnifolia 'Northline', Zone 2, ripe: Jun, shrub, sweet blueberry-like fruit, great fresh/jam, self-fertile

Barberry, Orange Rocket

Berberis thunbergii 'Orange Rocket', Zone 4-9, 4-5 H x 2-3 W, vibrant coral-orange new foliage turns a medium green before ruby red in autumn, compact, vigorous upright growth



Currant, Alpine

Ribes alpinum, Zone 2-7, 3-5 H x 3-5 W, dense green foliage, great hedge/screen, tough and adaptable, sun-part shade, drought tolerant once established



Barberry, Royal Burgundy

Berberis thunbergii 'Royal Burgundy', Zone 4-8, 3-4 H x 2-3 W, deep burgundy foliage holds color, compact mounded habit, drought tolerant, full sun best



Dogwood, Arctic Fire Red

Cornus sericea 'Arctic Fire Red', Zone 2-8, 3-5 H x 3-5 W, Beautiful red stems peak in winter sunlight, dwarf variety, tolerant of wide range of soils, partial shade tolerant, 1-2 year old stems have best color, trim to maintain optimal color



Buckthorn, Fine Line

Rhamnus frangula 'Fine Line', Zone 2-7, fine feathery texture, upright columnar habit, very hardy tough plant, vertical accent for perennial garden or frame entryways, works well in large containers



Dogwood, Cardinal Red Osier

Cornus sericea 'Cardinal', Zone 3-8, 8 H x 10 W, tiny fragrant white flowers turn to white berries, dark green foliage turns to reds, oranges and purples, bright red stems add winter interest



Burning Bush, Dwarf

Euonymus alatus 'Compactus', Zone 4-9, colorful accent or natural hedge, feature at the foreground of large evergreens to showcase this intense scarlet fall color



Dogwood, Prairie Fire

Cornus alba 'Prairie Fire', Zone 2-7, very hardy and colorful accent shrub, brilliant red fall foliage drops to reveal flaming orange-red stems for winter contrast

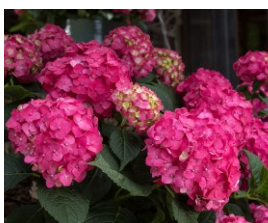

Hydrangea paniculata 'Fire and Ice', Zone 3-8, 3-5 H x 3-5 W, white blooms shift pink-red, compact, strong stems, sun-part shade, hardy and easy



Lilac, Dwarf Korean
Syringa meyeri 'Palibin', Zone 3-7, 4-6 H x 5-7 W, dwarf form for smaller gardens, dark purple buds, flowers fading to lavender, reddish-purple autumn hue

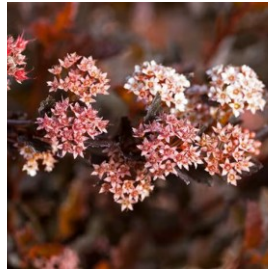

Acer tataricum ginnala 'Hot Wings', Zone 4-10, 18 H x 18 W, Bright red summer seeds contrast green foliage, tolerate dry, clay, alkaline challenging soils



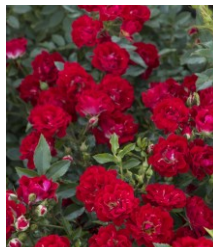

Feather Reed Grass, Karl Foerster
Calamagrostis acutiflora 'Karl Foerster', Zone 3-8, Full sun to part shade, silvery seed heads turn wheat colored and last into winter, upright clump



Blue Fescue, Boulder
Festuca glauca 'Boulder Blue', Zone 3-8, Full sun to part shade, superior color tough grass with strict clump form



Little Bluestem, The Blues
Schizachyrium scoparium 'The Blues', Zone 3-9, standout steel-blue foliage through summer, tidy, upright habit; color shifts to smoky purple, copper, and burgundy in fall, and strong stems hold form well into winter



Blue Fescue, Elijah
Festuca glauca 'Elijah Blue', Zone 3-8, Full sun to part shade, dense fine blue foliage, performs best in full sun and dry soil



Little Bluestem, Smoke Signal
Schizachyrium scoparium 'Smoke Signal', Zone 3-8, blue green foliage turns deep purple in summer, brighter tone in fall, strong stems maintain form until freeze



Brome Grass, Skinner's Golden
Bromus inermis 'Skinner's Golden', Zone 3-8, Full sun to part shade, unique golden-yellow foliage, clump-forming and upright habit, adds bright color and texture to landscapes, drought-tolerant and adaptable to various soil types



Oat Grass, Blue
Helictotrichon sempervirens, Zone 4-8, Full sun, clump-forming with blue-gray foliage, oat-like flower spikes in summer, drought-tolerant, perfect for borders, rock gardens, and mass plantings



Feather Reed Grass, Variegated
Calamagrostis acutiflora 'Overdam', Zone 4-8, Full sun to part shade, upright clumps with green and white striped leaves, feathery plumes in summer, drought-tolerant, ideal for borders and mass plantings



Oat Grass, Bulbous, Variegated
Arrhenatherum elatius 'Variegatum', Zone 4-8, Full sun to part shade, clump-forming with green and white striped leaves, small flower spikes, drought-tolerant, great for borders and ground cover

Switchgrass, Heavy Metal

Panicum virgatum 'Heavy Metal', Zone 4-8, Full sun, blue grey leaf blades turn yellow in fall, loose weeping purple green heads rise above foliage

Bergamot

Monarda fistulosa, Zone 3-8, Full sun to part shade, red stems, green foliage and lavender flowers provide loads of color and attract pollinators, dry to moist soils



Clover, Purple Prairie

Dalea purpurea, Zone 4-8, Full sun, purple and gold flowers on delicate foliage, heat and drought tolerant, dry to medium soils



Big Bluestem

Andropogon gerardii, Zone 3-8, Full sun, very tall grass, color changes with season, seed heads add color contrast and interest



Grama, Blue

Bouteloua gracilis, Zone 3-8, Full sun, short grass in distinct clumps, tight attractive seed heads, dry to medium soils



Black-Eyed Susan

Rudbeckia hirta, Zone 3-8, Full sun to part shade, yellow daisied with dark centers, self sowing seeds will spread to open soil, adaptable in dry to moist soils



Grama, Side Oats

Bouteloua curtipendula, Zone 3-8, Full sun, bright purple orange flowers and bright green foliage, very attractive, dry to medium soils

Indiangrass

Sorghastrum nutans, Zone 3-8, Full sun, brown plumes with yellow anthers over clumps of upright metallic blue foliage, adaptable to many soil conditions



Sedge, Fox

Carex vulpinoidea, Zone 3-7, sun to part shade, forms dense, arching clumps of bright green foliage, attractive seedheads resemble fox tail, thriving in moist soils



Iris, Blue Flag

Iris versicolor, Zone 3-8, Full sun to part shade, patches of deep blue flowers, use on edges of water features, tolerate standing water, high moisture required



Onion, Nodding Pink

Allium cernuum, Zone 4-8, Full sun, nodding clusters of pink flowers, onion like scent, long lived, hardy, tolerate dry to moist soils



Little Bluestem

Schizachyrium scoparium, Zone 3-8, Full sun, colors change with season, tolerates heat and drought, dry to medium well drained soils



Phlox, Prairie

Phlox pilosa, Zone 4-8, Full sun, bright pink flowers spring to summer, dry to medium soils



Lobelia, Great Blue

Lobelia siphilitica, Zone 3-8, Full sun to part shade, brilliant true blue flowers, medium to wet soils, will tolerate brief periods of drought



Prairie Dropseed

Sporobolus heterolepis, Zone 3-8, Full sun to part shade, mounds of arching fine foliage, neat clump with good fall color and edible seeds, tolerates many soils, even heavy clay with drainage



Milkweed, Swamp

Asclepias incarnata, Zone 3-8, Full sun, erect clump forming with small fragrant pink flowers, attractive seed pods, thrive along ponds, streams and water features



Rough Blazingstar

Liatris aspera, Zone 4-8, Full sun, wands of lavender flowers grow in sandy to loamy dry soils, great for birds and pollinators

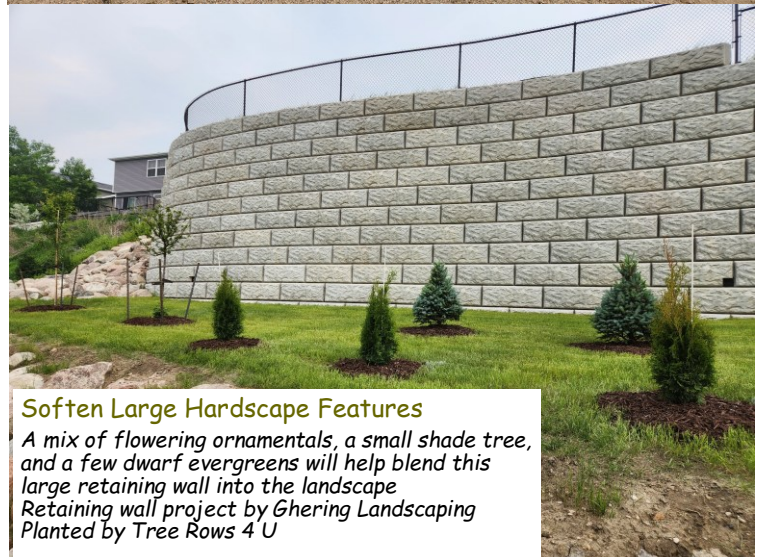

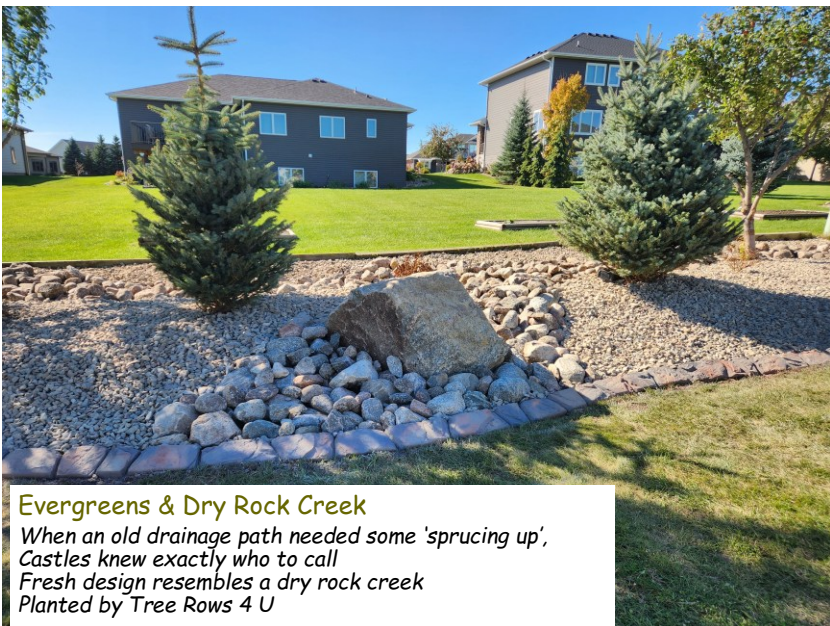

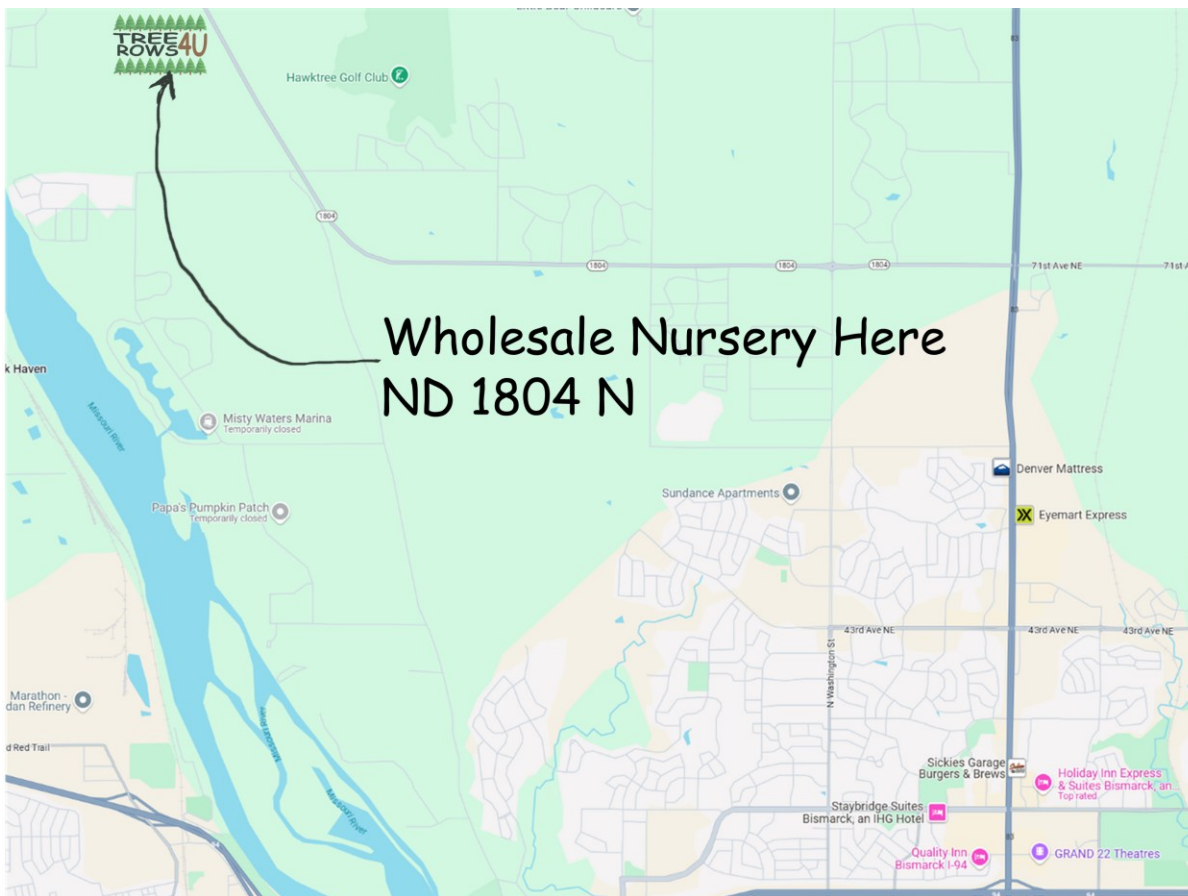
